Re: State of Georgia v. Genarlow Wilson

Dear Attorney General Baker:

The May 22, 2007 editorial headline of the Atlanta Journal-Constitution shouts: "Still room for justice, 10 year team must be overturned Thurbert Baker has the power and Genarlow Wilson deserves it." The December 21, 2006 editorial headline of the New York Times shouts: "Free Genarlow Wilson Now." The April 30, 2007 editorial headline of the New York Times shouts: Georgia's Shame." And we, the membership of Kappa Boule of Sigma Pi Phi Fraternity, totally agree as expressed through the unanimous vote of our membership last evening, May 24, 2007. Please see our names on the attached roster.

The time is now for Genarlow Wilson to be released from prison. He already has been incarcerated for over two years. During that time, the Georgia Legislature has changed the law under which he was convicted. There is nothing remaining to be accomplished by keeping Genarlow Wilson in jail. The highly accomplished young man should be freed so that he can resume his life of achievement and go on to college, which is where he was headed before he was prosecuted under the law that no longer exists.

The pivotal court hearing in this matter is scheduled to take place on June 6<sup>th</sup>. This situation demands that someone stand up and say enough is enough. You have that authority, and you have that ability. We beseech you to exercise both and take a posture with the court that will not oppose Genarlow Wilson's immediate release. We and many, many other citizens of the State of Georgia and this entire country strongly will support you in that endeavor.

Attorney General Baker, it is the right thing to do. Now is the time, and you are the person to make it happen. We have absolute confidence in your wisdom, solemn discretion, and sense of justice seeing that Genarlow Wilson should be freed NOW!
